## Minutes

1. Approval of meeting minutes of 5/9/18: Approved by Renee Pagnani, seconded by Bob Tirelli.
2. Financial Report: *Nancy McCann*: Money that went into account was from Heritage, Disney Deposits, Jazz Fest raffles. Money that came out: Parade truck, Master Classes, pizza for band at graduation. Ending balance \$16,193. Money to be allocated for Disney overpayment (\$680), Auditorium upgrades (\$3000), Jeanne Jarvie and Conti funds; leaving free cash at \$7658 into September. Last year the free cash was \$6790.
  - a. The MEF grant was approved for 2 array speakers, woofers, etc. A check for \$10, 849.33 was dropped off by MEF at the Superintendent's office.
  - b. We don't need to expand because classes are getting smaller.
  - c. Master Classes. \$4000 was allocated, but not all was used. Earmark \$4000 for next year, leaving \$3600 in free cash.
3. Fundraising recap: Snack and popsockets pulled in less than \$500. Concert raffle netted \$500, Mattress sale was \$4,000, Recycling netted approximately \$4,000, Jazz Fest netted \$3,200.
4. Awards recap: \$8,900 total awards giving this year. \$300 x 2 for All State. Frances Russo won the Jean Jarvie award. \$8,300 total to Seniors (Bria Dox, Ryan Gregory, Taylor Hussey, Allia Langill, Ryan McCann, Frances Russo, Elizabeth Sullivan, Olivia Tirelli).
5. MMPA elections for officers for 2018-2019:
  - a. Candidates:
    - 1) Diane Winship - President
    - 2) Sherrill (Sherry) Roach - Treasurer
    - 3) Lorraine (Lori) Dox - Secretary.
  - b. Motion to elect all 3 candidates approved by Claudia Giustra and seconded by Renee Pagnani.
6. School committee task force update: The task force had its final meeting then went to the school committee meeting. It didn't go well. They have another meeting scheduled for next Tuesday regarding facility usage, function of boosters and will go back to the school committee next Wednesday. MMPA is now to be considered a Partner of Masco.
7. Enrichment programs for 2018-2019:
  - a. Master classes: Allocating same amount as this year.
  - b. Auditorium upgrades: MMPA will allocate \$3000 on a new line item.
  - c. Performance tickets?

- d. Disney trip cost: There is an increase in cost due to the time of the trip. Bob booked Delta seats. He will check the cost of Southwest when they release their prices in August. He will shop for the best price. There will be 1 band and 1 chorale performance in Downtown Disney. The trip is sold out. 2 special needs students going.
8. Fundraising Events:
- a. Recycling event: 10/13/18. Bob Tirelli will chair. Need to find a new company that is NOT NE Handling.
  - b. Shredding event: 4/27/19. Mike Walsh will chair. We raised approx. \$2800 last time.
  - c. Jazz Fest event: Need a date and a chair for it. Randy proposes we move it from a Monday to a Friday, May 10th? There are no more Early Release Days, the school moved to Delayed Openings.
  - d. Randy can now put in dates on the calendar without getting approval. We cannot do too many fundraisers; the school committee will complain.
  - e. Spirit Wear is all online.
8. New Business:
- a. One of the gift cards from the Jazz Fest had no balance on it. That will be researched and card giver contacted. From now on, we will ask for a receipt with the gift card donated.
  - b. A 0.6 FTE Drama teacher position has been created. There were 28 applicants. Randy narrowed it down to 12. He and other music/drama teachers narrowed it to 6 after looking at resume packets. Randy and the 2 principals will narrow it to 2 and send to the superintendent. The candidates must have a Masters degree and 3 years experience. The new teacher will teach 1 HS class and 1 MS class. Program will feed the MS into the HS. The teacher will have to develop a program and build from ground up. There will be a MS musical the first year.
  - c. Our website is paid through 10/9/20. The website coordinator will have to remember that so our site doesn't lapse.
  - d. We no longer have a tailor. She is starting her own business. We need to find a new one.
